



Robin Class, Reception Summer Term 2026 Part 1



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will continue to support the children learn techniques to help them with a range of different emotions.

We will be exploring and naming healthy foods and understanding how they help our bodies grow strong.

Communication and Language

The children will be encouraged to respond to and ask a range of questions such as who, what, when, how, where and why.

Physical Development

The children will be encouraged to develop their gross motor skills through building, climbing and moving in a variety of different ways in our outside area. Our PE lessons will be focused on using different equipment when hitting. They will also be encouraged to develop their fine motor skills to control small tools such as scissors, tweezers and pencils.

Maths

The children will build on previous experiences of numbers to 10 and further develop their subitising and counting skills. They will explore the composition of numbers within 10. They will begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison.

Literacy

We will be continuing our Phonics lessons looking at the phase 3 sounds, looking at digraphs. We will be reading words with multiple syllables. The children will be working in small groups or 1-1 to develop their mark making skills into writing using phonics.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will provide lots of opportunities to sing, dance and express themselves in dramatic role play. The children will be encouraged to use construction and collage materials to create their own pictures and models. In adult led activities, the children will be exploring print making using a range of materials.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about The Fens and the different geographical features that are unique to the Fens. We will also be creating our own maps.
