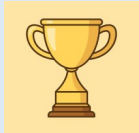

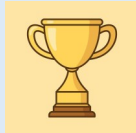

I thoroughly recommend you attend this workshop as it will provide useful tips to support your child in keeping them safe online as well as preparing them for their transition to secondary school.





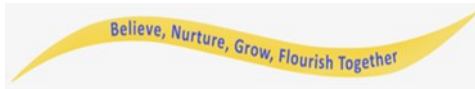
