

Home Learning Project Autumn 1 2026

Your child can choose one of the following projects below to complete over the course of this term for their home learning. There will be an opportunity in the last week of term to share the finished project with the rest of the class. Every child should be ready to contribute a presentation of their own. A timetable will be made available the week prior to the first presentations on Seesaw. The presentations are more than a “show and tell” and should evidence collaborative research and study at home about an area of our topic work that interests them most. The best presentations tend to be those that have started earlier in the half-term, as the children are able to speak confidently about their chosen area of study. Geography— UK	Computing—mouse skills	Science— Our Bodies
We will be learning about the countries in the UK over this half term. Can you choose a city in the UK and find out more about it? What is it famous for? Have you ever been there or would you want to go there? You could create your own information booklet, or record a tour guide video discussing the things you have learned.	We are using sketchpad.com in computing and will be exploring lots of the tools on the programme. Can you use sketchpad.com to create a portrait of someone in your family? You could save your portrait and send it to Mrs Hedges, or print it to bring it in. Tell us about the person you chose to create and what tools you used.	We will be exploring our 5 senses in Science; touch, smell, taste, sight and hear. Could you go on a senses hunt around where you live? You could take photos and tell us about all the different things you could see, smell, hear, touch or even taste!
RWE—Why is the word ‘God’ important to Christians?	Art—drawing	PSHE— Working together
We are learning about why God’s name is important to Christians and we will be looking at the parable of the Precious Pearl. What is precious to you? Can you tell us about something that is important to you and how you take care of it to make sure it stays safe? You could film a video or create a poster.	We are going to be exploring drawing in art this half term. We will be using a range of different drawing resources to help us to do this. We are also going to explore how sketch books are used by artists and use our own to practice and explore skills. You could create your own sketch book and fill it with your own drawings from your imagination or observations. We know that most things are made easier by working together. Could you and your family work together to do something? It could be making a meal, building a project, cleaning a mess etc. You could share some photos with the Robins about what each person in your team did and explain why it was important they were there.
