



# Key Instant Recall Facts

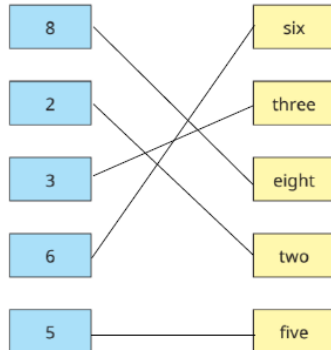
Year 1 – Autumn Term 1

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **with speed and accuracy**:

## I can read and write numbers to 10 in numerals

Children should be able to identify numbers to 10 and write them in numerals.

*For example, children should be able to match the numeral to the word.*

### Top tips

The secret to success is practising *little* and *often*. Use time wisely. Can you practise this KIRF whilst walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise all aspects of the KIRF all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day, or a few facts per week to practise? Write a number between 1 and 10 in words and ask your child to write the numeral, as well as vice versa. Collect a number of objects and ask your child to write how many in numerals and words.
